We resettle over 200 refugees annually from Latin America, Asia, Africa, Europe and the Middle and Near East.



Who is a Refugee

A refugee is someone who has been forced to flee his or her country because of a well-founded fear of persecution for reasons of war, violence, race, religion, nationality, political opinion or membership in a particular social group. Due to these reasons, a refugee can not go back. All refugees are legally admitted in this country.
